As all racers know, when drag racing, it is important to record time slip information as well as other variables such as weather and drag strip conditions. They need to know all sorts of information about how a car is tuned on each occasion, as well as launch and shift points and a host of other details they all like to collect.

Graham H. Robins explains, "In the past, we found that we were writing this information on the back of time slips and sharing it with others who would help to tune our car. Some time ago we began entering this information on a spreadsheet that allowed us to see at a glance a lot of comparative information. Having seen the benefit of utilizing technology to record this information, we thought about other information and services being offered free on other sites and wondered if there was a method by which others could go online to record time slip information and their car data."

The result is www.testandtune.com, which has now been expanded to include several other automotive interests.

Aftermarket suppliers are asked to advise testandtune.com of opportunities for deals which can then be passed on to testandtune.com members which will allow them to purchase items of value at very good prices. It is important to note that this information would only be sent to those members whose vehicles would indicate they would be seriously interested in that specific item.

Racers are asked to provide detailed vehicle information to ensure that only pertinent information is emailed to them. Suppliers would need to provide details of sales items by make, model and year to ensure that only those interested would be notified.
